New contracts in the US education segment worth EUR 123 million

Construction services for Deloitte University in Texas - Construction management for research building in Philadelphia

HOCHTIEF subsidiary Turner has won new contracts in the education segment in the USA, worth approximately EUR 123 million (USD 180 million). In Westlake, Texas, the company will provide construction services for Deloitte University. The project volume is EUR 89 million (USD 130 million). In addition, Turner is to manage construction of the Constantine Papadakis Integrated Sciences Building, a new research facility at Drexel University in Philadelphia. The project has a volume of approximately EUR 34 million (USD 50 million).

The auditing company Deloitte will use the education facility on the more than 433,000-square-meter site in Westlake as a learning and leadership development center for its employees. The project will seek a LEED Gold Certification from the United States Green Building Council and be handed over to the client in 2011. In Philadelphia, Drexel University's new research building will feature 39 laboratories on 12,820 square meters of space. It is planned to be LEED Silver certified and completed in June 2011.
