HOCHTIEF wins three new contracts worth over EUR 250 million

Archive building in Duisburg, Germany - Medical campus in Buffalo, New York - Energy production infrastructure center in Charlotte, North Carolina

Through its subsidiaries HOCHTIEF Construction and Turner, HOCHTIEF has won three new contracts in Germany and the USA with a total value of over EUR 250 million: HOCHTIEF Construction won the tender to construct the Northrhine-Westphalia State Archive in Duisburg. The company will be adding a tower and adjoining office building to the listed 200-meter long silo, originally erected in 1936. Construction will start in April 2010 and will be completed by the end of 2012.

The US subsidiary Turner has already provided preconstruction services on a medical care and research center in Buffalo, New York, and is now handling the construction services. The healthcare facility at Buffalo Niagara Medical Campus will have ten floors and an area of just under 45,000 square meters. The project is already under construction and is due for completion at the end of 2011.

Turner is also providing preconstruction and construction services in Charlotte, North Carolina where it is constructing an energy production infrastructure center for the University of North Carolina. The building contains almost 19,000 square meters of seminar rooms and laboratories. The center is being designed and constructed to achieve an LEED Silver certification from the United States Green Building Council and will be handed over to the client in November 2011.
